The Argyle Trio has a change of pianist for this concert. Laurence Matheson, the trio's pianist, is an Australian, and so unable to travel because of the pausing of the Trans-Tasman bubble. Wilma and Matthias are both New Zealanders, so could get into New Zealand. We are delighted that Michael Houstoun has stepped in as pianist — we couldn't have a greater substitute. As a result, there is a change in programme.

THE PERFORMERS:

Wilma Smith, violin, is past Concertmaster of the New Zealand Symphony Orchestra and a much-loved chamber musician here and in Australia, where she now lives. She was Concertmaster of the Melbourne Symphony Orchestra from 2003-2013, and is now a teacher of violin and a champion of emerging talent. She and Michael Houstoun are longstanding musical partners, so his inclusion in this concert will be a 'coming home'.

Matthias Balzat, cello, is an outstanding young cellist who received a scholarship from the Waikanae Music Society Charitable Trust for Young Musicians in 2017. At age 14, he commenced his Bachelor of Music Performance degree at the University of Waikato. Since then, he has won every major instrumental competition in New Zealand, and was awarded the prestigious Patricia Pratt Scholarship to study in Germany, where he is currently studying for his Master of Music.

Michael Houstoun, piano, needs no introduction. He is a national treasure and has performed so often for our Society, we made him a Life Member last year at his then 'final' concert. We are so glad he has come out of retirement and *will* again grace our stage.
